## Reviewers praise Lexmark T644 laser printer

Workgroup monochrome laser printer recognized for its user friendly design, innovative productivity enhancements and performance

PC Magazine recommended the Lexmark T644n as a good choice for businesses reliant on the fast printing of documents. It praised the Lexmark T644n for exceptional performance, stating, "The T644n is, quite simply, the fastest legal- and letter-size monochrome laser we've seen in its price class."

BLI tested the Lexmark T644dtn, which adds duplexing, network capabilities and additional paper capacity to the base model. BLI commented in particular on the unit's reliability, stating, "The Lexmark T644dtn offers excellent reliability, completing its 125,000 impression test without experiencing a single misfeed and no service calls required."
